RESEARCH: Describe the artistic research you intend to explore in your residency. Explain its significance and how it aligns with the vision transdisciplinary of das LOT. This should be a full one-page document answering to our criteria below.

PORTFOLIO: Provide a portfolio that showcases your past work and collaborative projects, if applicable. This will help us understand your artistic practice and background.

CONTACT INFORMATION: Include your name, contact details, and any additional information you believe is relevant to your application.

1. TRANSDISCIPLINARY COLLECTIVE: We encourage collectives or artist groups of two and more individuals working across different disciplines to apply. Collaboration and cross-disciplinary exchange are essential to the spirit of das LOT.

2. TRYING OUT SOMETHING NEW: We actively promote collectives or artist groups to experiment with new and innovative formats with open outcomes during their residency.

3. WHY LOT? Please specify in your application why you believe LOT is the ideal space for your residency. Is it the size, location, and identity of das LOT that suits your needs? Please articulate also what you specifically would require in terms of resources and environment.

4. PUBLIC COMMUNICATION: As part of the residency, we kindly ask you to publicly communicate your artistic research at the end of your residency. This can take various forms, such as presentations, workshops, installations, or other engaging formats at the end of the residency. The focus is not on performing or showing a result but on sharing your process and state of research for collective learning.

5. ARTISTIC RESEARCH: Das LOT strongly emphasizes artistic research and its process rather than solely focusing on completed projects. We encourage artists to delve into critical inquiries, explore concepts, and experiment with new methodologies that contribute to the broader research qualities of contemporary art.
