- Only completed artworks, pieces close to completion, or works with a realistic time frame of being finished by the exhibition date will be accepted. Please provide a timeline and details outlining the completion process for your submission
- A short list of the technical means required for the presentation submitted artworks must fit the criteria of interactivity and must correspond to the given topic
- All the documents need to be submitted in PDF format. (max. 5 MB each)
- Participating artists will receive a small honorarium to help with offset material and travel expenses
